Sustainable development of alpine open spaces by enhancing spatial planning governance

Near-natural open spaces in the Alps are very important for biodiversity and human wellbeing. They are decreasing due to human interventions and the resulting landscape fragmentation.

The **OpenSpaceAlps** project addresses this issue from the perspective of spatial planning with the objective to maintain open spaces as part of the alpine green infrastructure.



The project runs from **10/2019** to **06/2022**.



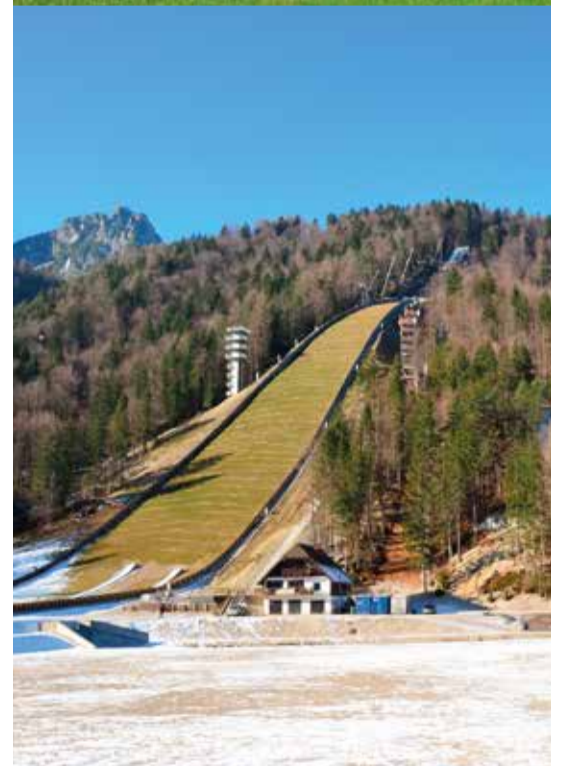
The **OpenSpaceAlps** project activities will result in:

- A planning handbook for alpine open spaces proposing new integrated approaches and planning instruments
- An Alps-wide visualisation and planning tool supporting transnational governance of planning strategies
- A transnational network of spatial and sectoral planning experts and practitioners enabling exchange and informing of decision makers
- Strategic recommendations contributing to coordination of efforts to preserve open spaces at the national and transnational levels
